

## **Village of Oak Park Business Guide Check List**

The Village of Oak Park, the Oak Park Economic Development Corporation and the Oak Park River Forest Chamber of Commerce are partners, here to assist new and existing businesses. This business guide check list will you help walk through the various steps involved in opening or expanding a business in Oak Park. The primary point of contact, for each step, is listed.

You want to develop a new or revise and existing business plan and/or locate the right site for your new or expanding business. Contact the Oak Park Economic Development Corporation. The Oak Park Economic Development Corporation can be reached at <u>contact@opdc.net</u>.

## Items to be checked off include...

- Complete your business plan, ensuring that you have thought through the project budget, local competition and business financials.
- Identify a storefront, office or other location that is suitable for your business needs.
- Understand local resources and non-profit network offerings to help you fill gaps in funding, or in knowledge, as you work to bring your business to Oak Park.

You need assistance navigating Village government processes, have questions about zoning requirements related to a site you've selected or have building permit or business licensing questions. Contact the Village of Oak Park. The Village can be reached at <u>business@oak-park.us</u>.

## Items to be checked off include...

- Contact the Village and schedule a "New Business Walk-through Site Visit" at your new physical location to get a better understanding of zoning and permitting considerations.
- Review the zoning requirements that may be applicable to your selected location.
- Ensure that your team of architects, building contractors and subcontractors are meeting all Village building and permitting requirements.
- ✓ Submit your Building Permit Application through Oak Park's VillageView web portal.
- Complete inspections and reviews with Village Staff throughout the construction process in order to obtain your required Village of Oak Park Occupancy Permit.
- ✓ Apply for and receive your Village of Oak Park Business License.
- Ensure that you have explored and completed the process for additional permits or licenses that your business may need (i.e. Liquor License, Outdoor dining permit, etc.).
